### ONE-WEEK PROGRAMS

#### Giant Steps Day Camp: JUL 9-13

**AGE RANGE:** 11-14

**PRICE:** \$895; Lunch: \$75;  
After care: \$150

**SCHEDULE:**

Monday-Friday, 9am-3pm  
After care (optional), 3pm-5pm

**AUDITION REQUIRED?** No audition, will have in person evaluation in June.

**ENVIRONMENT:** A great introduction to our summer jazz workshop programs and the most guided. Fun day camp environment where the day is broken up with social activities. Environment similar to Junior High.

**CURRICULUM:**

- Designed for middle school students; campers are supervised at all times and guided between classes and activities.

- For instrumentalists and vocalists with at least 12 months experience on their instrument.
- Play in big bands and small combos or sing with the vocal ensemble.

**SPECIAL ACTIVITIES:** Student Showcase concert on Friday afternoon. Daily outdoor games and activities.

**ON-CAMPUS HOUSING & MEALS?** No housing; catered lunch available.

#### Jazz Camp: Week 1 JUL 15-20 • Week 2 JUL 22-27

**AGE RANGE:** 12-17

**PRICE:** \$1,450; Housing & Meals: \$990

Evening concerts 7:30pm-9:30pm

**AUDITION REQUIRED?** No audition, will have online evaluation.

**ENVIRONMENT:** Jazz Camp offers a more intensive program than Giant Steps Day Camp and is more guided than Jazz Institute. The level of playing can be just as advance as it is in Jazz Institute, but students receive more

curriculum guidance since each student is given a schedule tailored to their specific strengths and weakness to make sure all students are challenged, but not overwhelmed. Environment is similar to High school.

**CURRICULUM:**

- Designed for teens and independent pre-teens. Each student gets a unique daily schedule tailored to their individual skills and learning goals.
- For instrumentalists and vocalists with at least 18 months experience on their instrument.

- Instrumentalists play in jazz combos; vocalists sing in a vocal ensemble and solo with professional accompaniment. Includes one private lesson.

**SPECIAL ACTIVITIES:** Student Showcase concert Friday evening. Free admission to Stanford Jazz Festival concerts. Faculty jam sessions at COHO.

**ON-CAMPUS HOUSING & MEALS?** Room and board available for ages 13-17. Girls and boys dorms grouped by age and supervised by experienced SJW counselors.

#### Jazz Institute: JUL 29-AUG 3

**AGE RANGE:** 12-Adult

**PRICE:** \$1,540; Housing/Meals: \$660-\$1,100

**AUDITION REQUIRED?** Audition required, for vocalists & students under 18.

**ENVIRONMENT:** Jazz Institute is designed for students who thrive in

a self-guided environment and want the freedom to design their own daily schedule. Environment is similar to college.

**CURRICULUM:**

- Designed for adults and advanced teens; choose your own schedule from dozens of daily class offerings.
- For instrumentalists and vocalists with at least 18 months experience on their instrument.
- Student instrumental groups

include combos, piano/guitar trios, Latin jazz band, and World Rhythms Ensemble

**SPECIAL ACTIVITIES:** Student Showcase concert on Thursday evening. Free admission to Stanford Jazz Festival concerts. Faculty jam sessions at COHO. Student jam session each day after class.

**ON-CAMPUS HOUSING & MEALS?** Counselor supervised room and board for 17 and under. Adult single/double housing available.

## TWO-WEEK PROGRAMS

### Giant Steps Package: JUL 9–20

Combines Giant Steps Day Camp and the first week of Jazz Camp.

**AGE RANGE:** 12–14

**PRICE:** \$2,345; Housing (week 2 only) & Meals: \$990

**AUDITION REQUIRED?** No audition, will have online evaluation.

**ENVIRONMENT/CURRICULUM:**

- Designed for middle school students who are ready for a challenge. The first week will build a solid foundation and the second week will take it to the next level.
- Students will first be in a guided environment with all middle school aged students and then during the second week students will be more challenged and in a environment similar to high school.
- One private lesson during the second week.

- Second week's classes build on the first week without any repetition. Each student gets a unique daily schedule tailored to their individual skills and learning goals.
- Two private lessons with a Jazz Camp faculty (one per week)
